Application Fees (by online portal link): Applicants have to pay application fee of **Rs. 300** through the online portal at www.nia.nic.in. Application Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

Course Fees: Selected candidates shall deposit a **course fee of Rs. 10,000 (Ten Thousand Only)** through the online portal. Candidates will be **intimated through phone or email** regarding their selection and shall be required to submit the course fees. The payment link and other relevant details will be communicated separately. Course Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
