In case of any unscheduled holiday taking place on the last day of issue of tender/ submission of tender/ pre bid meeting the next working day shall be treated as the scheduled time and day of issue of tenders/ submission of tenders.

The bid shall be valid for 180 days from date of opening of Price Bid.

#### 2.1 Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

The technically and financially sound Consultancy firms who fulfill the following basic requirements are eligible to participate in this tender:

a) i. Should have successfully provided Consultancy for following "similar works" during the last 05 (Five)years by the end of the month prior to the date of NIT:

One similar completed work costing (construction cost) not less than amount equal to 80% of the estimated project cost for consultancy work.

OF

Two similar completed works each costing (construction cost) not less than amount equal to 60% of the estimated project cost for consultancy work.

OR

Three similar completed works each costing (construction cost) not less than amount equal to 40% of the estimated project cost for consultancy work.

ii. The Similar works means "Providing Engineering, Design & Consultancy Services for architectural & structural design, Geo-Technical investigation, Soil Investigation, Surveying Work design and detailed estimation, Detailed Project Report (DPR), Conceptualization & Design Layout plan / drawings, detailed planning, landscaping & external developments, designing & detailing of all services their drawings & approvals for Office/ Commercial/ Institutional Building Works.

The experience certificate in this regard should be issued by officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer/ Project Manager.

- b) Should have Average Annual Financial Turnover on "Consultancy Services" at least 50% of the estimated cost put to tender in the last three years ending 31.03.2023, Certificate duly certified by a Chartered Accountant is to be submitted.
- c) Net worth of the bidder should be positive.
- d) Should not have incurred any loss during the immediate last five financial years ending

- 31.03.2023. Copies of balance sheet/ certificate from Chartered Accountant are to be submitted.
- e) Should have registered with Council of Architecture (COA) (copy of COA to been enclosed).
- f) The Firms must not be black listed or debarred by any Organization at time of submission of bid and no work awarded to Firms should have been terminated on the ground of unsatisfactory performance. The Firms are required to submit under-taking in this regard.
- g) JV/ Consortium are not allowed.
- h) Should have valid Permanent Account Number of Income Tax. (Copy of PAN to been closed).
- i) Should have valid GST Registration number (Copy of GST Registration to been closed). Along with latest G.S.T. Returns.
- j) Agency must have all Directors or Partners as Architect with valid registration from Council of Architecture as per the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India order with at least 10 years of experience.
- k) The Consultant firm requires furnishing details of Skilled and Trained Manpower including Engineers, Architects and Technical Staff employed and details of various Software and Hardware available with consultant.
- I) The experience certificates issued by Government Organizations / Semi Government Organizations / State Government Public Works Department / Central Government / Public Sector Undertakings / Autonomous Bodies / Municipal Bodies eligibility of the Public Limited Companies / Non-government organizations shall be accepted for assessing the eligibility of tender.
- m) However, the certificates issued by a Public Limited Company / Non-governmental Organization must be supported by TDS certificates in support of value of work done by the tenderer.
- n) The bidders are advised in their own interest to visit the site to study/assess the tendered work & also acquaint themselves of the prevailing local conditions before submitting their bid.
- o) If any credentials submitted by bidder are found false/ fraud, the bidder shall be debarred from future tender of National Institute Of Ayurveda, Jaipur, besides rejection of bid.
- p) Agency must have its own full-fledged office preferably in Jaipur, Rajasthan.
- q) Bidder should submit the Power of Attorney to sign the tender documents, Tender Fees & EMD, Affidavit as Annexure-A-1 & Annexure-A-2 (format enclosed with this NIT) on Rs. 500/non-judicial stamp paper must be submitted at the time of online bid submission (as applicable).
- r) Bidder have to submit confirmation letter whether they are registered under MSME sector not and if yes, then relevant copies of the registration letter (Registered under single point registration scheme of NSIC, Govt. of India, Ministry of MSME, Jaipur vide gazette notification

dated 26.03.2012 along with the form of Memorandum- 2 with the concerned DIC) to be submitted at the time of online bid submission along with a request letter for exemption from submission of EMD, fees.

- s) For evaluation purpose, the completion cost of works mentioned in the Completion Certificate shall be considered. The experience certificate in this regard should be issued by Officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer/ Project Manager/ Unit Officer.
- t) The bid must be uploaded online by an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) (Original) of Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand only). This can be either in the form of crossed Demand Draft or pay order only of any Nationalized Bank/ Schedule bank or Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee (with SFMS) form any of the commercial banks, safe guarding the purchaser's internet in all respects:
- u) Bidder should sign the Integrity pact on Rs.500/- stamp paper duly notarized (Form at attached with said NIT).
- v) Professional liability insurance (PLI) of the project is in the scope of consultant and charges of the same shall be included in the fee quoted by the consultant.

#### 3.0 The Scope of work is briefly given below but not limited to:

- 1. The brief Scope of Work but not limited to Providing Consultancy Services for architectural & structural design, Geo-Technical investigation, Soil Investigation, Surveying Work design and detailed estimation, Detailed Project Report (DPR), Conceptualization & Design Layout plan/drawings, detailed planning, landscaping & external developments, designing & detailing of all services their drawings & approvals, MEP Works, preparation of technical specification, Bill of Quantities, tender documents, firefighting, CCTV, Water Harvesting, Electrical works, HVAC works, 3D view STP External lighting, Obtaining all statutory approvals for designs & drawings (for B+2 and G+4) wherever applicable from concerned authorities for Building works complete scope.
- 2. Consultant shall carry out Geo-technical investigation related to construction work as below:
  - i) Soil strata and bearing capacity for construction of Building Works.
  - ii) CBR value of sub-grade material for design of construction.
  - iii) Finalization of suitable borrows area or source of good engineering soil for construction.
- 3. Finalization of Conceptual Plan after Topographical survey & geotechnical investigation.
- 4. Architectural, structural designs & drawings as per the scope of work and approved concept plan and their approvals by laws of local Authority. Drawings and proof checking wherever applicable from any IIT/ NIT/ Govt. Institute of India as directed by client.
- 5. DPR shall be prepared on the basis of Delhi Schedule of Rates, C.P.W.D., Central Schedule of Rates (MORTH) as applicable to on the date of signing of agreement, unless otherwise directed by client. For water supply & sewer D.S.R. shall be followed. For electric works D.S.R. / relevant SOR shall be followed. Non D.S.R./S.O.R. items shall be based on market survey. Consultant shall be solely responsible for the correctness of market rates taken in DPR.
- 6. DPR shall be prepared by consultant after due diligence including required site survey, investigation, testing and designing as per relevant codes. Drawing including and x-sections, showing H.F.L. structural drawings of all ancillaries. Detail of measurement, bill of quantities, abstract of cost shall form an integral part of DPR. Consultant shall be solely responsible for correctness of DPR, design, drawings, items, quantities etc. even after approval by the client.
- 7. Consultant shall follow codes and specifications as under for preparation of DPR:
  - i) Central Public Work Department (CPWD) specifications.
  - ii) MORTH
  - iii) Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS)
  - iv) National Building Codes(NBC)
  - v) Indian Road Congress Codes
  - vi) Procedure and quality Standard Specified by the ULB/ local authorities.
  - vii) Central Public Health and Environment Engineering Organization (CPHEEO) norms.
  - viii) Norms not covered in (i) to (vii) above and applicable to the construction of Building work with the approval of the competent authority.
- 8. Preparation of detailed estimates, rate analysis, BOQ, drawings and other documents along with tender conditions, specifications and their approvals from all concerns for callingtenders.
- 9. Issue of Eight sets of "Good for Construction" working/ detailed drawings for execution of works.
- 10. Revision of the drawings, if required due to site conditions or changes in site location requiring re-

preparation/ revision of proposal/ drawings, etc.

- 11. Consultant shall develop various plans for submission to other organizations for obtaining their approvals from various departments and various approvals for said project from other State Authorities, wherever required shall be arranged by Consultant.
- 12. Necessary statutory or approval charges shall be reimbursed on submission of relevant documents to National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur.
- 13. Consultant to obtain necessary approvals from relevant departments, wherever required National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur shall coordinate & file all papers/applications (wherever required, National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur officials will sign relevant papers).
- 14. Consultant shall do Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA), wherever required. Consultant will study and prepare environmental management / mitigation plans if required. The statuary fee and/or charges levied by the Government shall be separately payable as per actual charges. Consultant will obtain the environmental clearance from the State/ Central Government, depending on the category of the project, for which all technical clarifications and details, as desired by authorities will be provided and followed up as per formats of Statutory Authorities by Consultant. National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur shall render and furnish necessary support wherever available and required within their purview.
- 15. Visit the site of work at regular intervals and where necessary clarify, offer interpretation of the drawings/ specifications, attend conferences and if required.
- 16. Prepare and submit completion reports and drawings for the project as required and obtain "NOC/Completion/Occupancy Certificate" from statutory authorities, wherever required.
- 17. Issue four set of as built drawings including services and structures one set also in softcopy.
- 18. No extra payment will be paid if any alteration is required by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur in design &drawing at any point of time.
- 19. The Consultant shall be associated till obtain relevant certificate from the concerned local bodies and Client.
- 20. The approved Conceptual Plan & detailed design, drawings will be copyright of National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur and it cannot be represented anywhere in future by Architect/ Consultant.

The online bid proposals should be in two parts:

- (i) The Technical Bid, which should contain the Design Proposal and other document required as per the terms& conditions of this NIT.
- (ii) The Financial Bid which should be as per the format given. The amount must be expressed in terms of percentage of the project cost.

#### 4. TAXES AND DUTIES

- The Bidder must be registered with GST in Rajasthan state and should have valid GST number. In case the bidder does not have valid GST registration number, the same shall be obtained by the successful bidder within one month from the date of LOI.
- The Bidder must submit as an compliances of GST Act, the invoices in GST compliant format
  failing which the GST amount including interest and penalty if any shall be recovered/
  adjusted by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur without any prior notice from the next
  invoices or available dues with National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur
- Rates to be quoted in this tender shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes & duties and GST etc. Taxes are to be disclosed separately in Price Bid/ BOQ.
- Price bid formats shall indicate "inclusive of all taxes and duties including GST.
- In case of any reduction in rate of GST or other taxes in future or the project getting exemption status prior to the last date of bid submission or afterwards, the contractor shall pass on the benefit to National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur immediately, failing which National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur shall have the right to recover the differential amount from the amounts due to the sub-Bidder. Further, in case of any increase in rate of GST or other taxes in future or the project losing exemption status prior to last date of bid submission or afterwards, the said increase of taxes shall be paid/ reimbursed to the subcontractor, subject to the condition that the client reimburses the said increased taxes to National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur.

In addition to the price bid format, an Annexure to indicate the "break up of cost and levies such as GST and other taxes" considered in the quoted prices shall be annexed. This Annexure shall have breakup of all taxes/ duties relevant to the contract.

#### 5.0 **Evaluation:**

5.1 The duly constituted Tender Evaluation Committee shall evaluate the Technical Proposals on the basis of their responsiveness to the Terms of Reference and by applying the evaluation criteria, specified in the NIT. In the first stage of evaluation, a proposal shall be rejected if it is found deficient as per the requirement indicated in the NIT for responsiveness of the proposal. Only responsive proposals shall be further taken up for evaluation. Evaluation of technical proposal will start first and at this stage the financial bid (proposal) will remain unopened. The proposals will be evaluated, based on the eligibility criteria and submission of all the requisite information/ documents as asked for in clause 3 of this NIT.

- For Every point, Cumulative marks will be allotted as per the above matrix, on the basis of submitted documents.
- For the points, if no supporting documentary evidence is available in the bid, Zero marks will be awarded against the same.
- Proof must be submitted in form of clear and legible document.
- Minimum 60% Marks in Stage-I (Technical Bid Evaluation) to be secured by the bidder for eligible for presentation.

#### Stage-II

#### **Design Concept Presentation:**

Max.(30Marks)

Under this stage, the Architect firm /Consultant shall be invited for participating in the design concept Competition by the way of presentation before the Committee constituted for the purpose by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur. Minimum one week time will be given for preparation of presentations to the Qualified Bidders.

The Consultant shall bring hard & Soft copy of their Design concept and related details at the time of presentation. The concept design to strictly incorporate all the parameters as mentioned below under Evaluation Criteria. The time and venue for presentation will be intimated separately.

The committee shall evaluate the presentation on design concept and would assign the marks independently and then the assigned marks would be averaged out.

The consultant shall have no right to challenge the marks assigned by the individual member of the committee and individual member of the committee shall have no liability to applicant in this regard. No correspondence would be pertained challenging or contesting the marking by the individual member of the committee.

The committee shall evaluate the design concept of consultants by applying the evaluation criteria, sub-criteria and point system as stipulated here in under.

Even though a bidder may satisfy the above requirements, he would be liable to disqualification if he has:

- i) Made misleading or false representation or deliberately suppressed the information in the forms, statements and enclosures required in the pre-qualification document.
- ii) Record of poor performance such as abandoning work, not properly completing the contract, or financial failures / weaknesses etc should be defined.

Selection of the consultants shall be subject to verification of their credential.

- 5.3 Evaluation shall be made under Combined Quality cum Cost Based System (CQCCBS). Under CQCCBS, the technical proposals will be allotted weight age of **70%** and only Bidder securing a minimum of 60%marks in technical evaluation (stage-I & II) shall be considered technically qualified. Financial proposals of only those firms who are technically qualified shall be opened publicly on the date & time specified to be notified, in the presence of the bidder representative who choose to attend bidder and their financial proposal shall be read aloud. Financial proposals will be allotted weight age of 30%.
- 5.4 Proposal with the lowest cost will be given a financial score of 100 (i.e. full 30 marks) and

other proposals will be given financial score that are inversely proportional to their prices.

- 5.5 The total score, both technical and financial, shall be obtained by weighing the quality and cost scores and adding them up.
- 5.6 **Highest points basis:** On the basis of the combined weighted score for quality and cost, the bidder shall be ranked in terms of the total score obtained. The proposal obtaining the highest total combined score in evaluation of quality and cost will be ranked as H-1 followed by the proposals securing lesser marks as H-2, H-3 etc. IncaseH-1bidderwithdraws, second highest bidder H-2 will be considered.

#### For Example:

Let's say there are 3 pre-qualified bidders: A, B& C

Technical Score of bidders after evaluation of technical criteria: A=70,B=80 &C=90

Say the % Consultancy Services Fee in the financial proposals of bidders is as under:

A=7%,B=5%&C=6%

The financial score is given as per the formula: (Lowest % Consultancy Services Fee against the

%Consultancy Services Fee of the bidder)X100

Financial Score of A =(5/7)X100=71.4%ofmarks 30

Financial Score of B=(5/5)X100=100% of marks 30 Financial

Score of C=(5/6)X100=83.3 % of marks 30

Final Combined Technical and Financial Score of the bidders is as per the formula:

(TechnicalScoreX0.70)+(FinancialScoreX0.30)

Bidder A=(70 X0.70)+(71.4%X30)=70.42--H3

Bidder B=(80X0.70)+(100% X30)=86.00---H2

Bidder C=(90 X0.70) +(83.3%X30)=87.99---H1

Hence Bidder C, with highest combined score shall be recommended forward.

- 5.7 Though an applicant may satisfy the eligibility criteria, National Institute Of Ayurveda, Jaipur reserves the right for not to consider the tender if he has record of poor performance such as abandoning work, not properly completing the work, delay in completion of work, poor quality of work, financial failure/ weakness etc.

- 7.0 In order to participate, the bidder should have Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) from one of the authorized Certifying Authorities.
- 8.0 Bidders have to necessarily register themselves on the relevant portal to participate in the bidding under this invitation for bids. It shall be the sole responsibility of the interested

bidders to get themselves registered at the aforesaid portal to complete the registration formalities.

- 9.0 Bids must be submitted/ uploaded along with scanned copies of relevant documents pertaining to Clause no. No. 3.0 of NIT under Bidding Procedure on the portal on or before last date & time of online bid submission. Late bids will not be accepted. Under the above procedure, only Technical Part shall be opened online on scheduled date & time of bid opening. Price part shall be opened of technically qualified bidders. If the above documents are not received in time then their offer shall not be considered and National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur shall not be responsible for any delay in respect of submission of the bids.
- 10.0 **Presentation by the Bidder**: A detailed presentation shall be made by the eligible bidder. The Venue, Date and time of the presentation will be intimated by email to the concerned Bidder.
- 11.0 The Terms & Conditions contained in this NIT and tender documents shall be applicable. In case of any unscheduled holiday falls on the last day of issue of tender/ submission of tender, the next working day will be treated as scheduled day and time for issue /submission of tender.
- 12.0 The corrigendum or addendum, extension, cancellation of this NIT, if any, shall be hosted on the National Institute Of Ayurveda, Jaipur's website/ CPP portal. - 4.1.10 The Associate Consultant shall be fully responsible for evolving safe, economic, technically sound and correct design and shall ensure that the planning and designing of the work is carried out based on CPWD, State PWD, Specification, latest ISI codes of practices, legislation, other relevant bye-laws and good engineering practices. The Associate Consultant shall guarantee the structural stability and performance of all the structures, conveyances system and services. The bill of quantities and specifications shall be as per National Buildings Code of India (NBC), CPWD, and relevant norms as desired by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur.

- 4.1.11 The Consultant will give undertaking that all drawings, design, specifications, plans, estimates and other documents will be prepared and furnished to suit the particular local conditions of the site in the most economical manner. The Associate Consultant will work out economic design and adopt specification so as to ensure that the estimates approved by client at initial stages are not exceeded on completion of work. At any stage during the progress of execution of the work, if any defect is noticed in the drawings, designs, specifications, plans, estimates or other documents, the consultant shall provide free of cost to National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur fresh designs/drawings/ specifications/ estimates and other documents within a period of the seven days from the date of notice issued by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur in this regard. The consultant shall also indemnify National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur for losses due to such defective drawings / designs / specifications / estimates / other documents supplied by the consultant subject to a maximum of the consultancy fees.
- **4.1.12** While providing consultancy services, the Associate Consultant shall ensure that there is no infringement of any patent or design rights and he shall be fully responsible for consequence/ any actions due to any such infringement. Associate Consultant shall keep National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur indemnified all the times and shall be ar the losses suffered by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur in this regard.
- **4.1.13** The statutory deduction of income tax, or other taxes / dues shall be made from the payment released to Associate Consultant from time to time and same are deemed to be included in the Associate Consultants fees and nothing extra shall be payable to associate consultant in this regard.
- 4.1.14 The Associate Consultant shall get the structural design checked & vetted from reputed technical Institute / College viz any NIT, IIT, Govt. Engineering College, Engineering College of State /Central Universities as directed by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur. All costs related to checking/ vetting shall be borne by the Associate Consultant and is deemed to be included in the fees mentioned in para 3.0.0. However, the checking of design and drawings of the Associate Consultant by technical institutes as above shall not absolve the responsibility of the Associate Consultant.

#### 4.1.15 Taxes and duties

- 1. The bidder/ contractor must be registered with GST and should have valid GSTIN number.
- 2. The bidder/contractor must submit as compliances of GST Act, the invoices in GST compliant format failing which the GST amount shall be recovered/ adjusted by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur without any prior notice from the next invoices or available dues with National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur.
- 3. The bidders/ contractor are requested to update/ upload the GST/ Taxes data periodically so as to avail ITC credit by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur failing which it shall be recovered/ adjusted by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur without any prior notice from the next invoices or available dues with National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur.

- 4. Rates to be quoted in this tender all inclusive with all taxes and duties etc. including GST.
- 5. Bidder while quoting the rates in the tender must also consider the ITC credit applicable for the works, if any.

#### **4.1.16** Insurance

Associates consultant has to take professional liability insurance policy (PLI).

#### 4.1.17 TERMINATION

This agreement may be terminated at any time by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur upon giving one month notice in writing being given to Associate Consultant, if the Associate Consultant 's work is not found to be satisfactory according to the terms of the agreement. In case the agreement is terminated on account of Associate Consultant's work not being satisfactory, National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur will get the work done at the risk and cost of the consultant.

#### **4.1.18 PENALTY**

In case the Associate Consultant fails to complete the work within the contract period or extended period mentioned in clause 4.1.10 above owing to reasons attributable to Consultant, liquidated damages @ 0.1% of per week shall be payable by consultant subject to maximum of 5.0% of approved project cost.

#### 4.1.19 FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE

National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur will not be responsible for any delay / stoppage of work due to force majeure conditions like natural calamities, civil disturbances, strikes, war etc.and losses suffered, if any, by the consultant on this account. National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur shall not be liable in any way to bear such losses and no compensation of any kind whatsoever will be payable by National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur to the Associate consultant.

#### 5.0 JURISDICTION

The Courts in Jaipur alone will have jurisdiction to deal with matters arising from the contract, to the exclusion of all other courts.
